(HALF YEAR, 2025 CRIME ANALYSIS.)



EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Crime Analysis:

In the quarter, two of 2025, a total of **11,588** criminal activities were formally reported to the various law enforcement agencies within the sample group that comprise of twelve counties that were carefully selected for this analysis, which are inclusive of the gazetted cities within the Republic of Kenya.

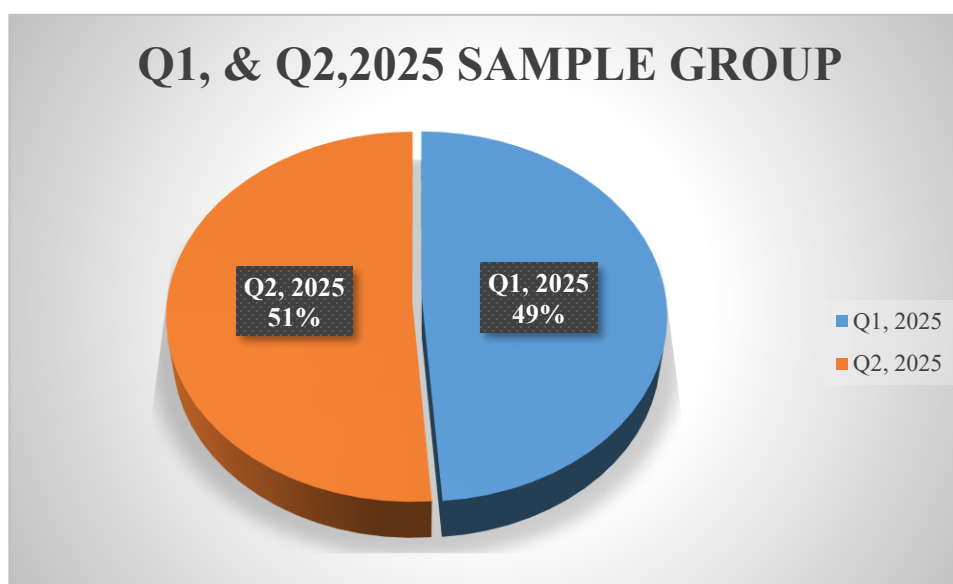
The crime statistics for the quarter two of 2025 shows a **4.90%** increase in crime rate in comparison to the crime statistics for the quarter one of 2025 whereby a total of **11,047** criminal activities were reported to the various law enforcement agencies within the sample group.

In a further crime analysis that has been done in relation to the crime rate as was experienced in the quarter two of 2024 in comparison to the quarter two of 2025, a **5.09%** reduction in crime rate was witnessed within the two mentioned review period. In quarter two of 2024, a total of **12,210** criminal cases were reported, this is **622** cases less compared to the **11,588** cases that were reported in the quarter 2 of 2025.

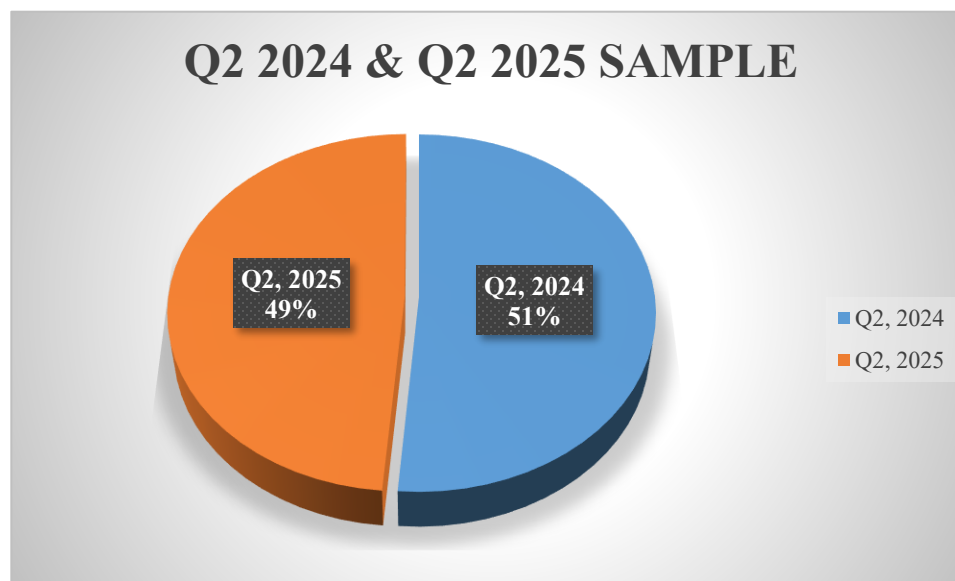
Graphical presentation: Quarter 1, 2025 Vs. Quarter 2, 2025 Sample Group:

Graphical Presentation: Quarter 2, 2024 Vs. Quarter 2, 2025 Sample Group:

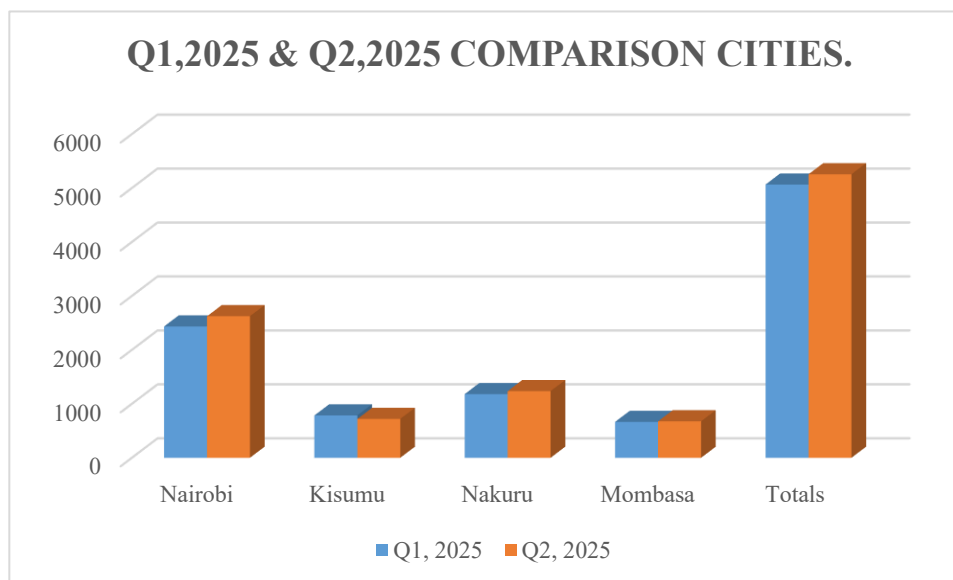


In a crime analysis that has been done with regards to the crime trend within the gazetted cities within the Republic of Kenya, these are Nairobi, Kisumu, Mombasa and Nakuru, **5,256** criminal cases were reported in quarter two of 2025. This is a **3.77%** increase in crime rate within the quarter two of 2025 in comparison to quarter one of the same year where a total of **5,065** criminal cases were reported to various law enforcement agencies within the mentioned cities.

Graphical Presentation: Quarter 1, 2025 Vs. Quarter 2, 2025 Cities:

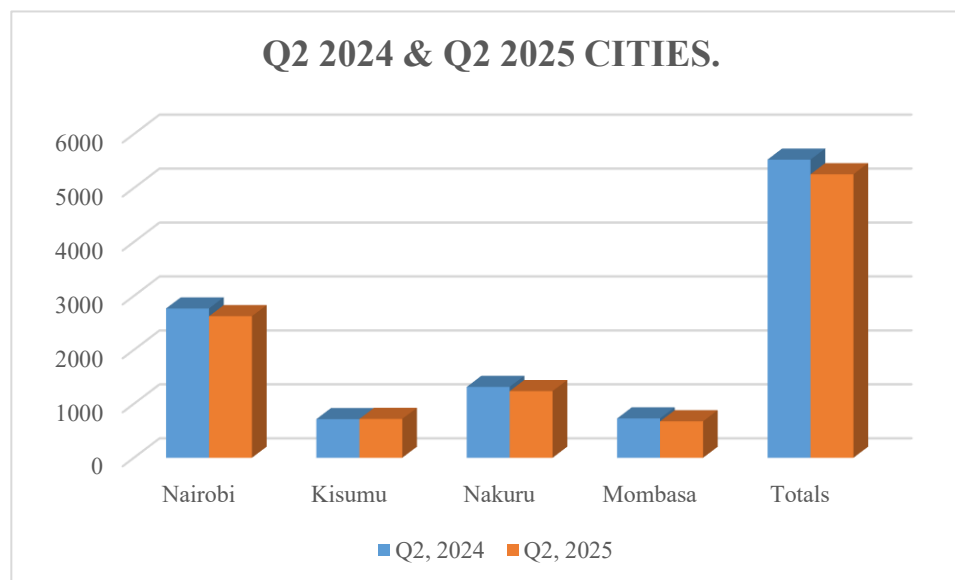


In a further crime trend analysis that has been done in relation to the crime rate that was witnessed within the mentioned cities in the quarter 2 of 2024 in comparison to the crime rate in quarter 2 of 2025, the number of criminal cases recorded under the mentioned duration reduced by **271** cases representing a **4.90%** reduction in crime rate between the two quarters in 2024 and 2025. A total of **5,527** and **5,256** cases were reported in quarter two of 2024 and quarter two of 2025 respectively.

Graphical Presentation: Quarter 2, 2024 Vs. Quarter 2, 2025 Cities:



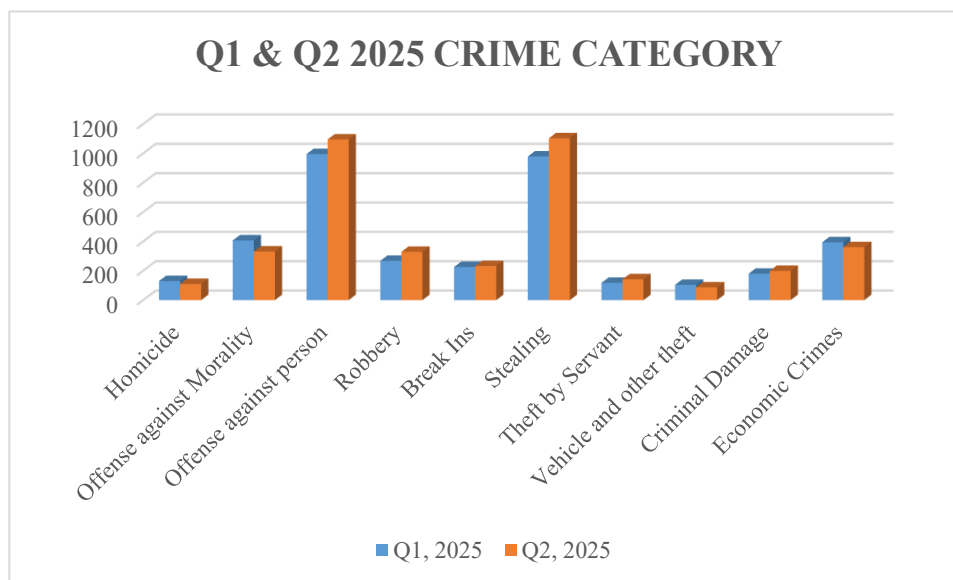
In the crime rate analysis that has been done in relation to crime classification per crime categories within the above mentioned cities, incidents falling under the category of robbery with violence were noted to have recorded in highest percentage increase at **22.76%** in the crime statistics analysis between the quarter one of 2025 in comparison to the quarter two of 2025 statistics. **268** cases and **329** cases were recorded in quarter one of 2025 and quarter two of 2025 respectively.

On the other have, cases relating to offences against morality were noted to have recorded the highest percentage decreased in the total number of cases that were formally reported between quarter one and two of 2025. This stood at **18.67%** reduction in cases within the above mentioned period of crime analysis.

Graphical Presentation: Quarter 1, 2025 Vs. Quarter 2, 2025 Cities (Crime Category :)



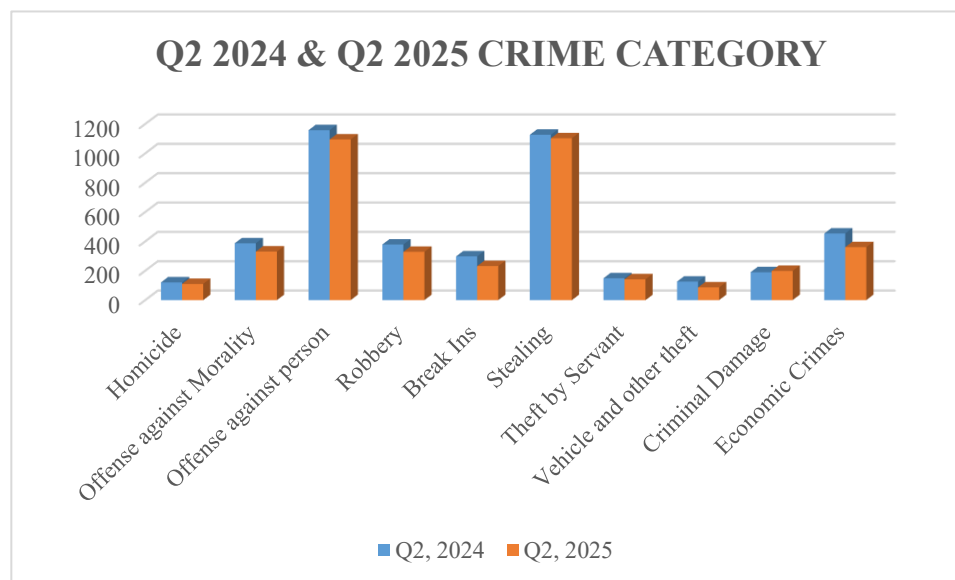
In a further analysis of crime rate per category of crime that has been done between the periods of quarter two of 2024 and quarter two of 2025, a reduction in the number of cases that were witnessed under each category was noted to have reduced except for incidents that fall under the category of criminal damage which witnessed a **4.74%** increase within the above period of comparison analysis.

The biggest reduction in cases reported per category in the analysis period are those relating to theft of motor vehicles, theft of motor vehicles parts and theft from motor vehicles. The statistics stood at 30.95% reduction and indication that motorists invested in the installation of anti-theft gadgets in their vehicles.

CRIME TREND HALF-YEAR ANALYSIS:

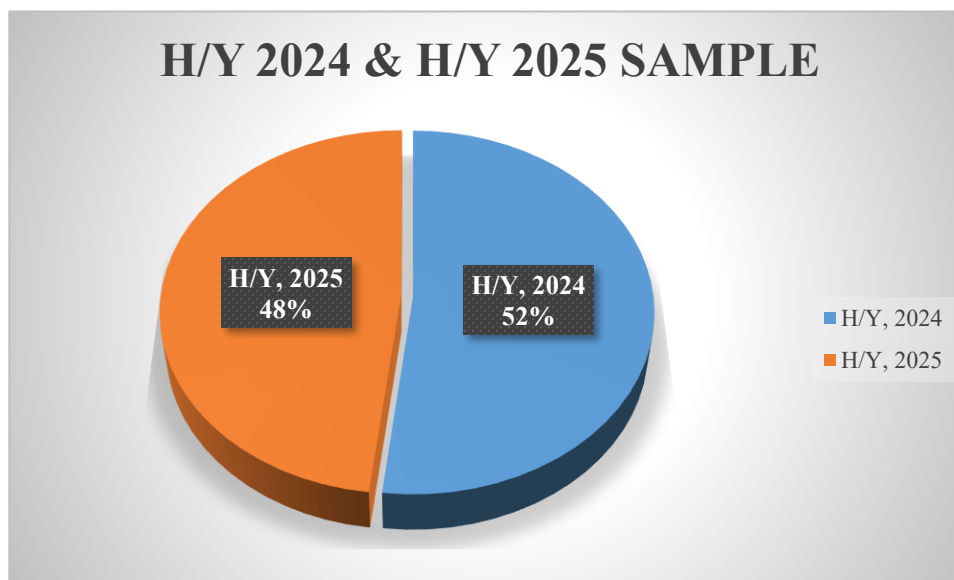
In the year 2025 to date, a number of criminal activities have been witnessed across the country with a number of them being captured and circulated across the various social media platforms. There are a number of criminal activities that were also captured and reported on the mainstream media with the county of Mombasa making headlines based on the terror that have been mounted on the residents through the organized criminal groups majorly comprising of youths who attacked and robbed of unsuspecting members of the public in broad day light. Similar situations were also witnessed in Nairobi and Nakuru Counties for a better part of the first half of the year 2025.

Despite the above trail of incidents having been reported in the first half of the year 2025, crime statistics reveals that there was a **7.26%** reduction in crime rate in the first half of 2025 in comparison to the first half of the year 2024. **24,415** cases were reported to the various law enforcement agencies in the first half of the year 2024 in comparison to **22,635** cases that were reported in the similar duration in 2025 within the sample group used in the crime analysis.

A similar trend was witnessed in the half year crime trend analysis that was done under the incidents reported in the four gazetted cities of Nairobi, Kisumu, Nakuru and Mombasa for the years 2024 and 2025.

An **8.50%** reduction in crime rate in the first half of 2025 in comparison to a similar period in the year 2024 was witnessed.

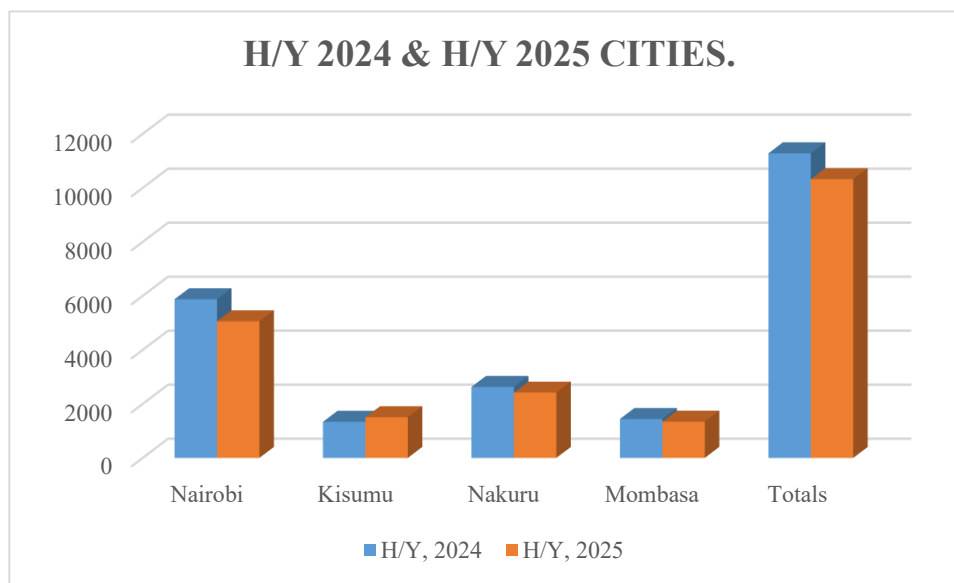
Three out of the four cities witnessed a percentage reduction in crime rate in the period referred to above with the highest reduction at **13.92%** being reported within the city of Nairobi. Nakuru and Mombasa cities recorded a **7.99%** and **6.94%** reduction in crime rate respectively.

On the other hand, The Kisumu City recorded an increase in criminal activities in the first half of the year 2025, whereby a total of **1,505** cases were reported in comparison to **1,336** cases that were reported during a similar period in the year 2024. This represents a **12.65%** increase in crime rate within the Kisumu City in the period under review.

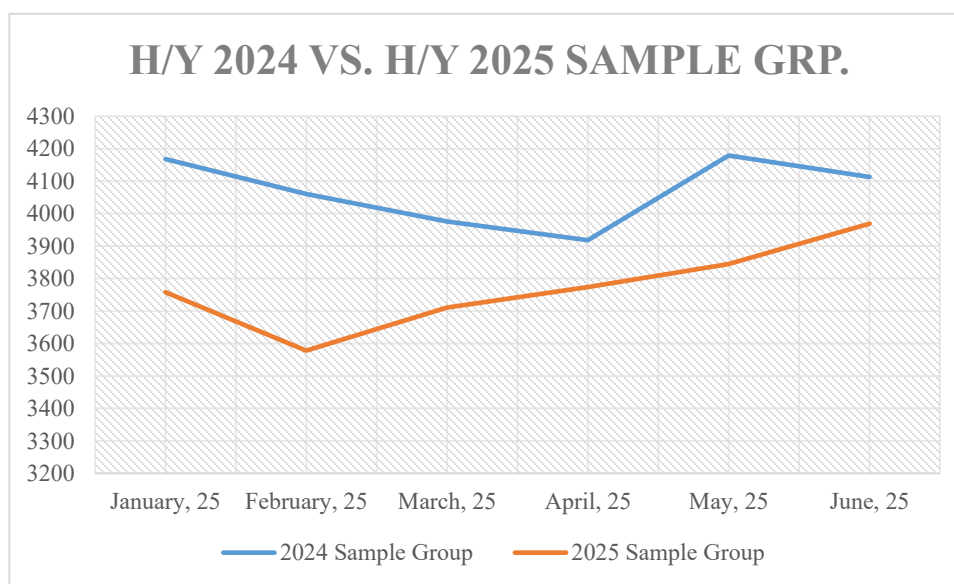
Graphical Presentation: Half Year 2024 Vs. Half Year 2025 Cities:

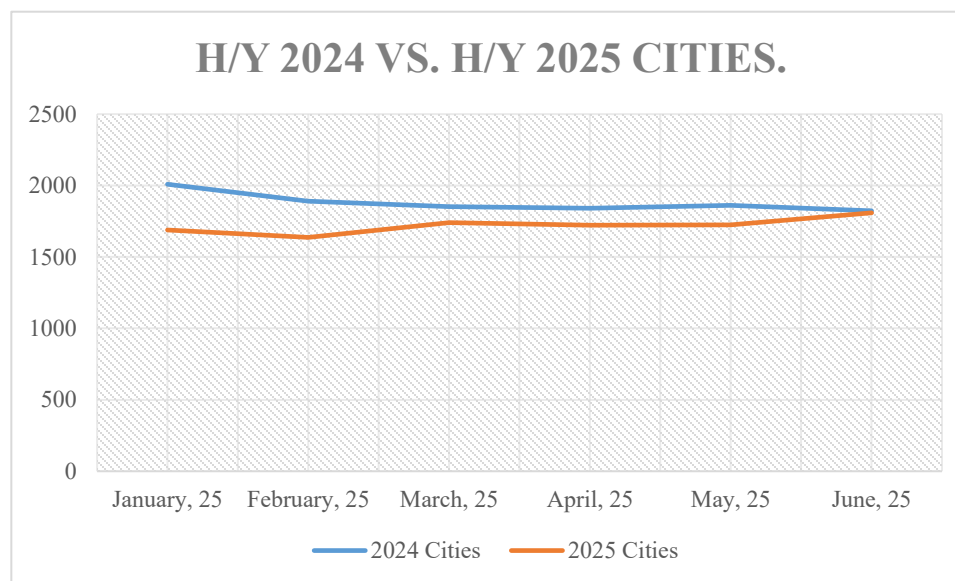
Graphical Presentation: Half-Year General Crime Trend: 2024 Vs. 2025:
