

CRIME REPORT

(ANNUAL CRIME REPORT - 2025.)



EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Crime Analysis:

In the sampled population of twelve (12) counties, a total of **44,368** crime related incidents were reported, **20,204** of which were recorded in the four gazetted cities of Nairobi, Kisumu, Nakuru and Mombasa hence accounting for **45.54%** of the total number of incidents recorded within the sample population. A **3.52%** reduction in crime rate was witnessed in the year 2025 in comparison to the 2024 crime data whereby a total of **45,989** criminal cases were recorded within the sample population. Within the four-gazetted cities as highlighted above, a **2.50%** reduction in crime rate was witnessed in 2025 in comparison to the 2024 crime statistics for the cities where a total of **20,722** cases were recorded.

In the first half of the year 2025, a total of **22,635** criminal cases were recorded, down from **24,414** cases that were recorded during a similar period in the year 2024, which depicts a **7.29%** reduction in crime in the period referenced above.

In as much as in the year 2025 crime was most prevalent in the first half of the year; the most number of criminal cases were recorded in the month of September whereby a total of **4,012** crime related incidents were reported. On the other hand, the least number of incidents were recorded in the month of December, 2025 whereby a total of **3,335** incidents were recorded. A **3.98%** reduction in crime was witnessed in the second half of 2025 in comparison to the first half crime statistics.

In the last quarter of the year, **10,181** cases were recorded, **2,261** of which were recorded within the Nairobi County accounting for **22.21%** of the total number of incidents recorded in this period. This is a **3.51%** reduction in the reported number of cases compared to those that were reported in quarter four of 2024 where **10,551** cases were reported.

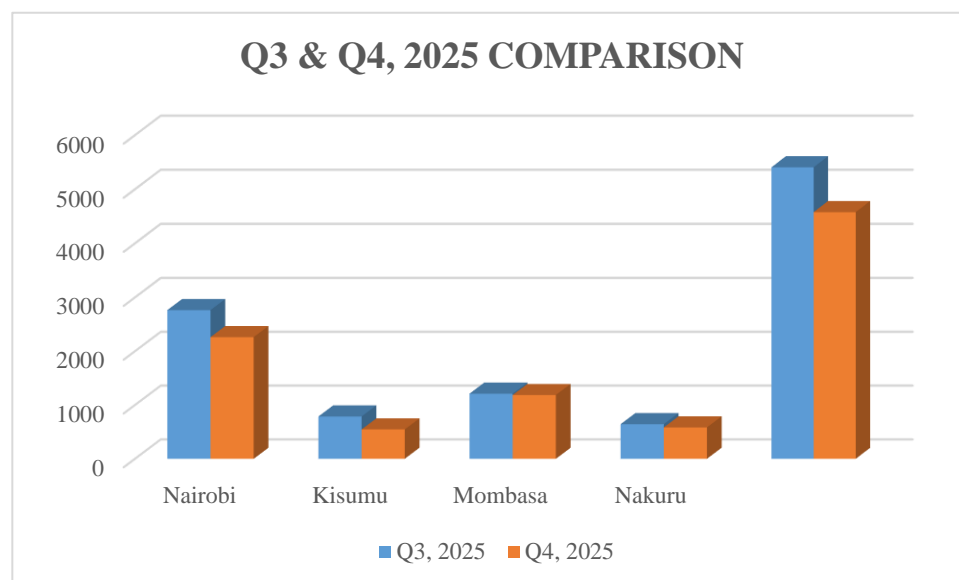
In quarter three of 2025, **11,552** cases were recorded in comparison to **11,023** cases that were recorded over a similar period in 2024 depicting a **4.80%** increase in crime in the period mentioned.

In quarter 2 and 1 of 2025, **11,588** cases and **11,047** cases respectively were recorded in comparison to **12,210** cases and **12,205** cases respectively that were recorded over a similar duration in the year 2024.

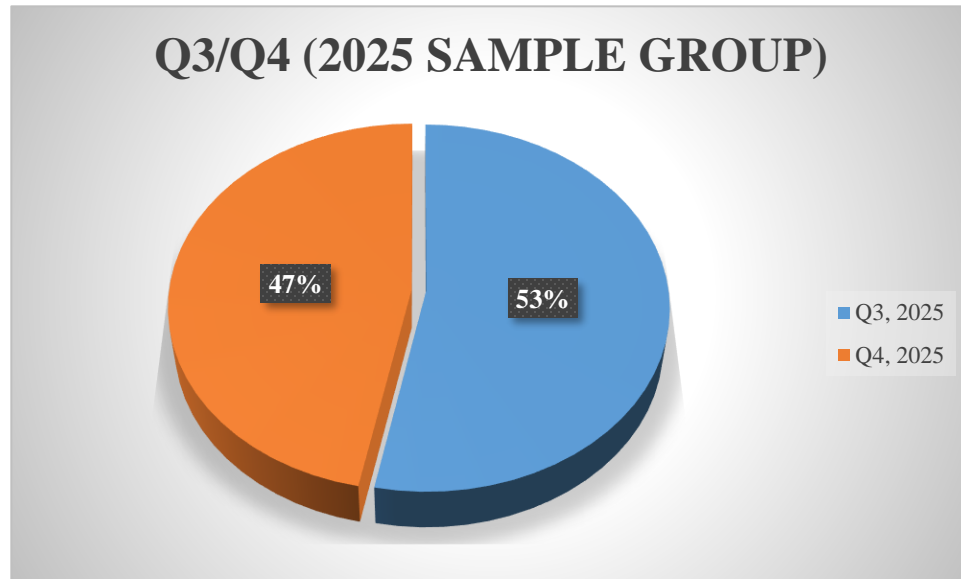

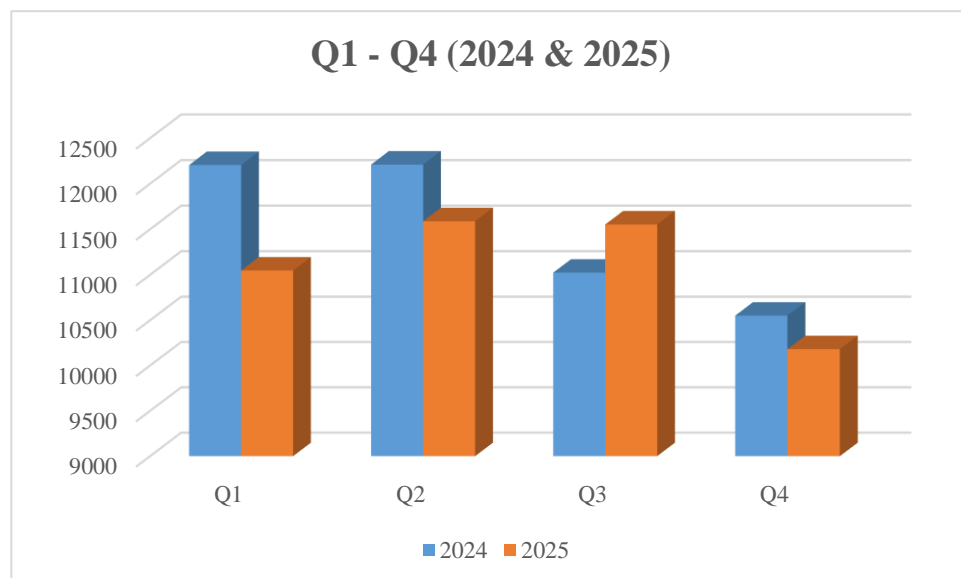
Graphical Data: 2025 Q 3 & 2025 Q 4 Comparison General Sample Group.



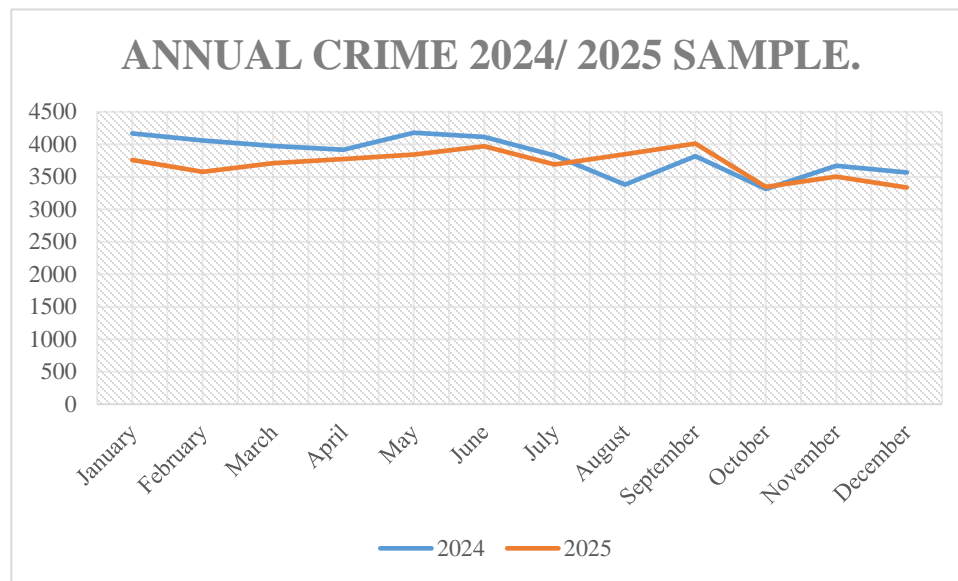

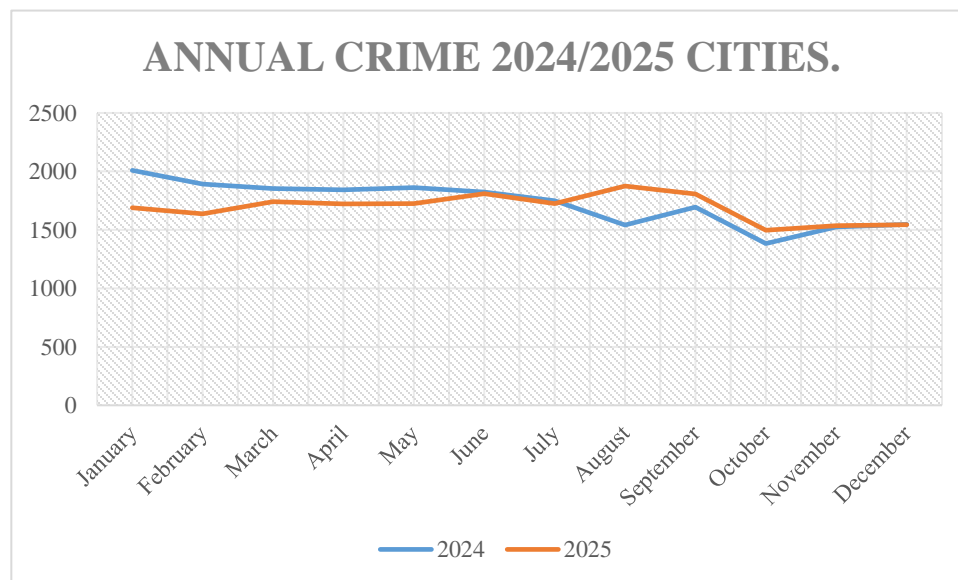
Graphical Data: Q1, Q2, Q3 & Q4 Comparison 2024/ 2025:

CRIME ANALYSIS PER CATEGORY:

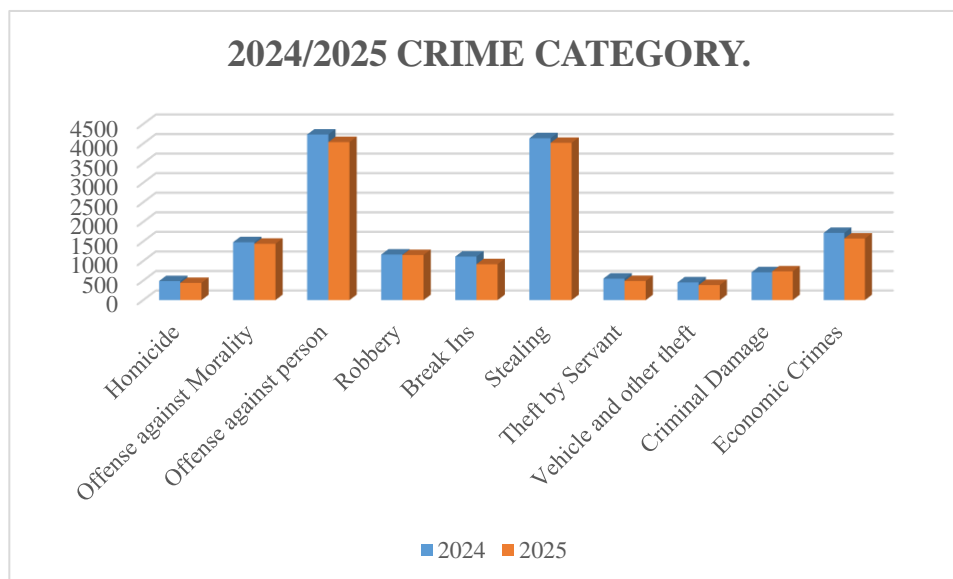
In the month of October and November 2025, stealing was the most common type of crime reported and so was the case in December where **319** cases were reported. Cumulatively, **4,019** cases were reported under the category of stealing in the year 2025. A majority of the cases were reported in the first half of the year whereby **2,082** cases were recorded in comparison to **1,937** cases that were reported in the second half of the year. The **4,019** cases recorded in 2025 is however, a **2.85%** reduction in the number of cases recorded in comparison to the 2024 crime statistics.

Similarly, cases relating to offenses against person were equally high in 2025. **4,039** cases were recorded, **2,090** of which were recorded in the first half of the year while **1,949** cases were recorded in the second half of the year. There was a reduction by **193** cases in 2025 in relation to offenses against persons crimes in comparison to the cases that were recorded in 2024 whereby **4,232** cases were recorded representing a **4.56%** reduction in the mentioned period.

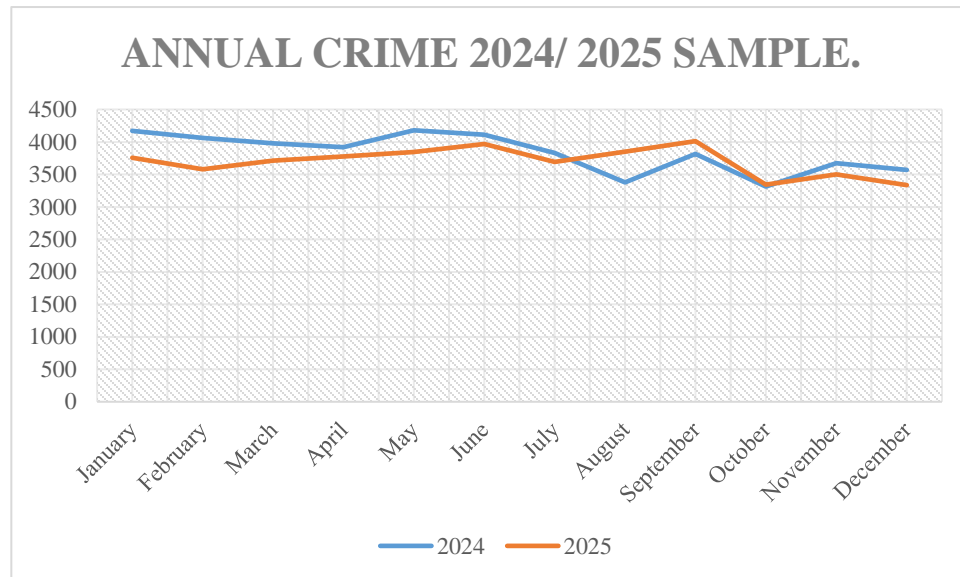


Nearly in all the categories of crime, there was a net reduction in the total number of cases that were recorded in 2025 in comparison to the 2024 crime statistics except for criminal cases that falling under the category of criminal damage which recorded a **3.09%** increase. **734** cases were recorded in 2025 in comparison to **712** cases that were recorded in 2024 in the four-gazetted cities of Nairobi, Kisumu, Nakuru and Mombasa.

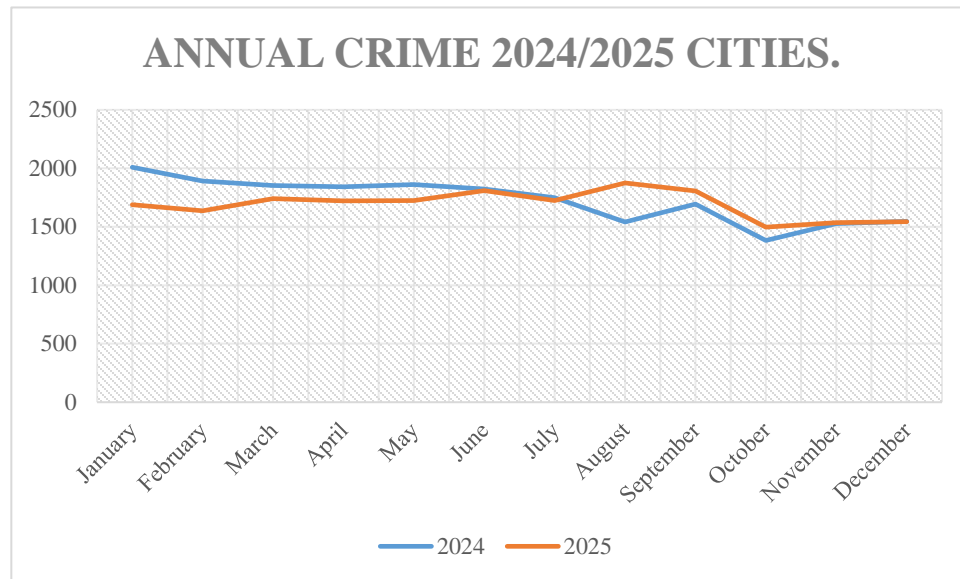
Graphical Presentation: Crime Trend, 2024/ 2025 Sample Population:
